Risk Description

Please give a brief description of the purpose for undertaking this Risk Assessment.

Following the Football Association announcement on the 18th of July 2020 that the government has given approval for the return of grassroots football and training sessions to restart.

This risk assessment intends to assess the risks associated with such a return by North Shields FC and offer mitigating actions to help ensure any return to football activities remain safe for all participants.



Understanding Risk

Inherent Risk – The risk of an incident happening if no control measures whatsoever are applied to the situation

Residual Risk – The risk of an incident happening after all specified control measures are applied to the situation


