Please give a brief description of the purpose for undertaking this Risk Assessment.

Following the Football Association announcement on the 19th of August 2020 that the government has given approval for the return of spectators to National League System games up to step 6 this risk assessment intends to assess the risks associated with such a return of competitive matches and spectators to North Shields FC's Home Stadium, The Daren Persson stadium and offer mitigating actions to help ensure any return remain safe for all in attendance.
